"I am the bread of life" – John 6:1-40 A Slow Walk with Jesus Lent 2024 - Part 2 of 9 Pastor Milt Van Natta

Event # 1 – Jesus teaches his disciples about the goodness of God and feeds five thousand hungry people.

- The miracle of provision in our midst

Event # 2 – The disciples cross the Sea of Galilee from Bethesda to Tiberias (North to Southwest over ten miles) and Jesus walks on the water.

- "Do not be afraid."

Event #3 – The next day Jesus feeds the five thousand again, but this time he feeds their souls.

- Our minds are hunger for truth
- Our hearts are hungry to love fearlessly
- Jesus is the bread (the nourishment, the satisfier of our souls) that our minds and hearts are longing to feed on.
