How God Works in Our Life Part 2 Pastor Milt Van Natta

Connect to last week: Instead of New Years' resolutions, it would be better to let God work in our lives. The Holy Spirit works by cleansing us of our sin, transforming our hearts, renewing our minds, and empowering our witness.

This week: How God makes us holy. We must be made holy to have a close relationship with God. How does the Holy Spirit make us holy?

Past Tense: The Holy Spirit has made us holy by covering us in the (imputed) righteousness of Jesus Christ. Genesis 15:1-17, Isaiah 61:10.

Present Tense: The Holy Spirit has made us holy by indwelling us with the (imparted) righteousness of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit purifies our hearts and minds daily. Ephesians 1:18-20. 2 Corinthians 5:17.

Future Tense: The Holy Spirit will make us holy and heaven-ready with a final work of righteousness called glorification. 1 Corinthians 15:50-58.
