Message notes for March 34, 2024

A storm front is moving into Jerusalem ... John 11:47-57 sets the scene as religious leaders plot the deaths of Jesus and Lazarus.

It is Saturday night in Bethany. Jesus, Lazarus, Martha, and Mary are dining at the home of Simon (Matthew 26) ... Mary enters the dining room and anoints Jesus with pure nard. Mary is bold to enter the room and bolder yet to let her hair down to wipe the nard off of Jesus' feet.

Nard is an expensive spice that grows only in Northern India. It is used for perfume (sweet smelling like gladiolas), breath freshener, and medicinal remedies. It is likely Mary's most valuable possession.

A spiritual thunderstorm breaks out in the room as Judas challenges Mary for "wasting" the nard ... Jesus defends her and says the nard is for his burial ... meanwhile curious villagers gather to get a look at Lazarus, the man raised from the dead.

All of Holy Week is a spiritual storm front in Jerusalem ... Judas' betrayal of Jesus, Peter's denial of Jesus, the crowd shouting down Pilate, and the crucifixion of the Lord Jesus Christ.
