Hearts on Fire: Four Spiritual Journeys

Journey One- First Time Through: Good News Bibles will be purchased tomorrow afternoon. All participants will be provided a Good News Bible by BSW. We will begin reading the New Testament one chapter a day on Monday, January 20th.

Journey Two- Daily Holiness: Participants must purchase a copy of *When Morning Gilds the Skies* by Dr. John Oswalt. The book is available for \$24.95 from Amazon. You will begin the daily devotions upon receipt of your book.

Journey Three- Praying for the World: Participants must purchase a copy of the *World Almanac and Book of Facts*. The book is available for \$15 from Amazon. We will begin our prayers on Monday, January 20th.

Journey Four- Morning and Evening Surrender. Participants must acquire a copy of John Baillie's *Diary of Private Prayer*. Used copies are available on eBay. A free pdf is available online. Google *Diary of Private Prayer* and a link will be listed for free online access. We will begin on Monday, January 20th and go through February 20th. Then start our second time through on March 1st.

There is still time to sign up for any of the four journeys. The journeying groups will gather quarterly to discuss how things are going.
