Thank you all for your faithfulness in praying for me and those who have answered the call to help whenever I have asked. I was finally able to see a specialist regarding my Lyme's and RA. Originally, I needed to wait until the end of the year, and in honesty I would not have lasted that long. I am also halfway through the care process from my surgery, and progress well despite the other issues.

God's faithfulness has been evident though as have your prayers. I started the first step of treatment and it's working immediately. For the first time in at least 6 months, I slept in my bed and for a full 8 hours. God has chosen not to miraculously heal me, but He has provided someone who is able to take me through a process to being better. My affliction will be lifelong (unless God changes His mind!)

I will still need to ask for help periodically, and I thank you in advance. Thankfully God has given me enough helpful friends that I don't need to burden any of you too much (I hope.) I would appreciate continued prayer not just for healing, but that God will work out paying this specialist. My insurance doesn't cover out of network care. Insurance is man-made though, and my faith is in the God who is ultimately in control of the universe.

On this, my birthday weekend, I rejoice in a God who has holds me up during this time of physical affliction. I am thankful to start getting back to a more normal life (like sleeping in a bed.) And I am thankful for you, my church family, who remembers me from time to time and holds me up with simple things in life, like prayers, cards, etc. May God bless each of you as much as He has blessed me through you.
