- 5) Pray for the efforts being made by the Trump administration for Middle East peace and an end to the war in Ukraine.

- 6) Pray for Governor Evers and the 33 state senators and the 99 state assembly persons of the state of Wisconsin. Pray for the candidates declaring for the governor's race in 2026.
